Debrief from the Executive Board Meeting 7/25/16

Including Enabling Office 365 Update

Michael Cockrill reviewed the [slide deck](#) that was shared at the Executive Board meeting. Michael reviewed a number of key themes in the material including:

- Broker Model
- Core Technology Investments, including the focus and importance of Identity Management
- Follow-up discussion with Exec Board regarding Network impacts from March 2016
- Enabling Office 365 and the Cloud Enablement. Michael shared that WaTech is developing a decision package that includes the network highway connection. He shared that WaTech is in the process of standing up the project to support this work.

WaTech Financial Update July 2016

Network Services: Discussion on Ethernet Contracting and Service Delivery Improvement Project

Mark Quimby provided an update to the Advisory Council about a project he has underway that is reviewing the overall business model for provisioning and procuring circuits. He wants to address unmet requirements from agencies regarding constraints in the current model. Mark shared that Phase 1 of the project is looking at the business model. Phase 2 will evaluate impacts to the network business he manages, and Phase 3 will review the requirements. Mark will provide the documented requirements to the Advisory Council to seek their feedback prior to implementation.
