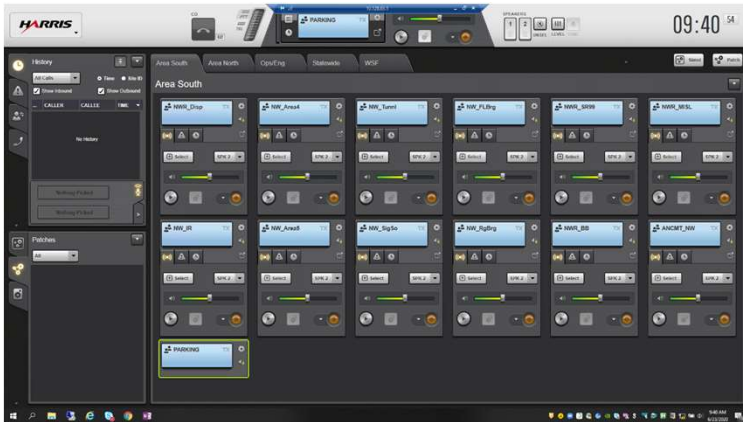

# Progress to date



- Project Status
  - Final project completion has shifted due to site lease issues and micro processor availability impacting equipment delivery. The Project team will be evaluating the schedule and completion of all project tasks in November. New estimated completion date is summer of 2022.
  - 130 of the 136 sites statewide are installed and operational.
  - Site work is complete in Northwest (NWR) and North Central (NCR), Olympic (OR), Southwest (SWR) and South Central (SCR) regions. Eastern (ER) region has 2 sites that are pending complete. The remaining 4 sites will be completed at the end of the project and are considered coverage improvement sites but not critical to operations.
  - Subscriber installs are completed in NWR and NCR, OR and SCR installs are underway. SWR and ER pending completion in OR and SCR.

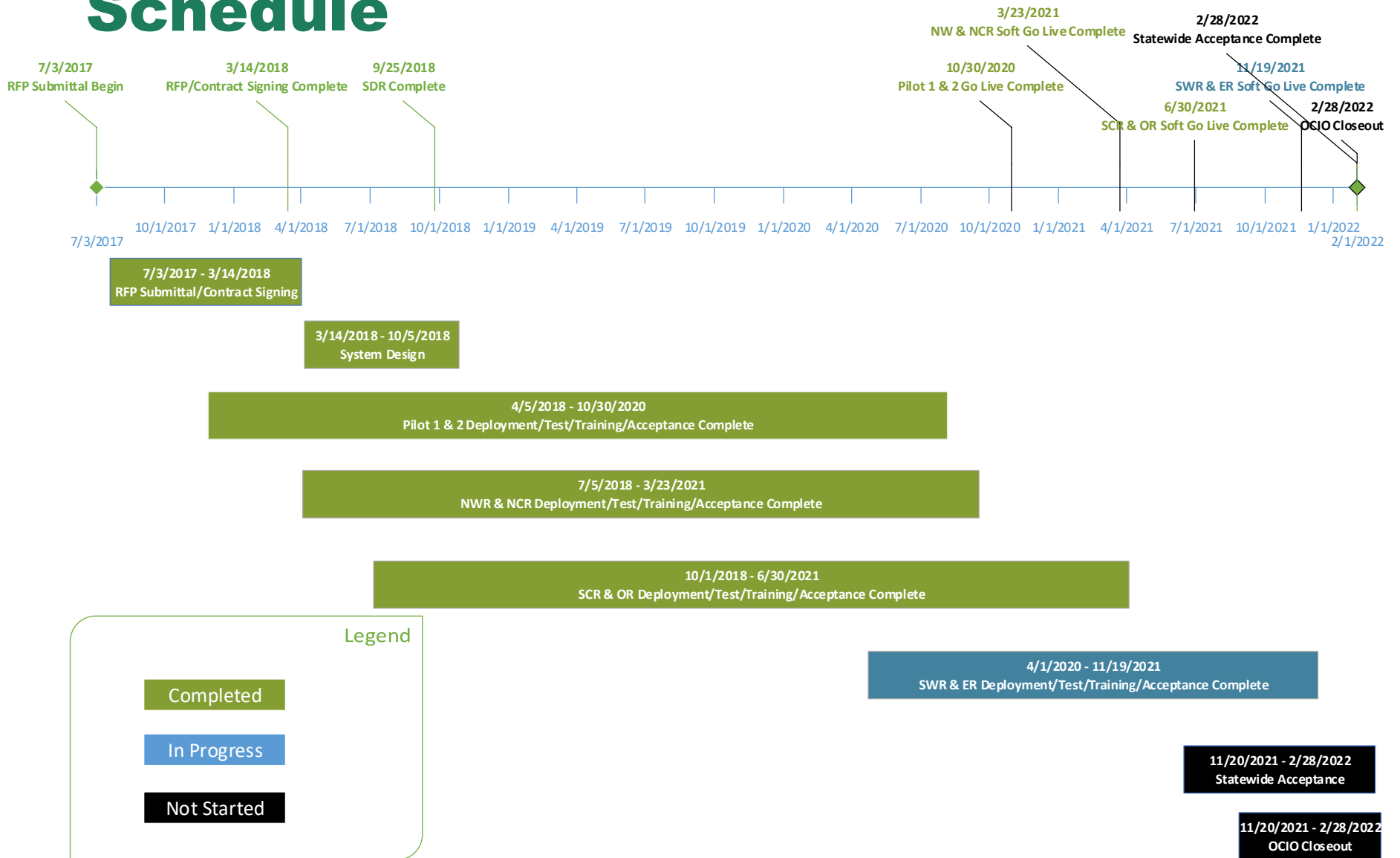

- System Final Acceptance in December.

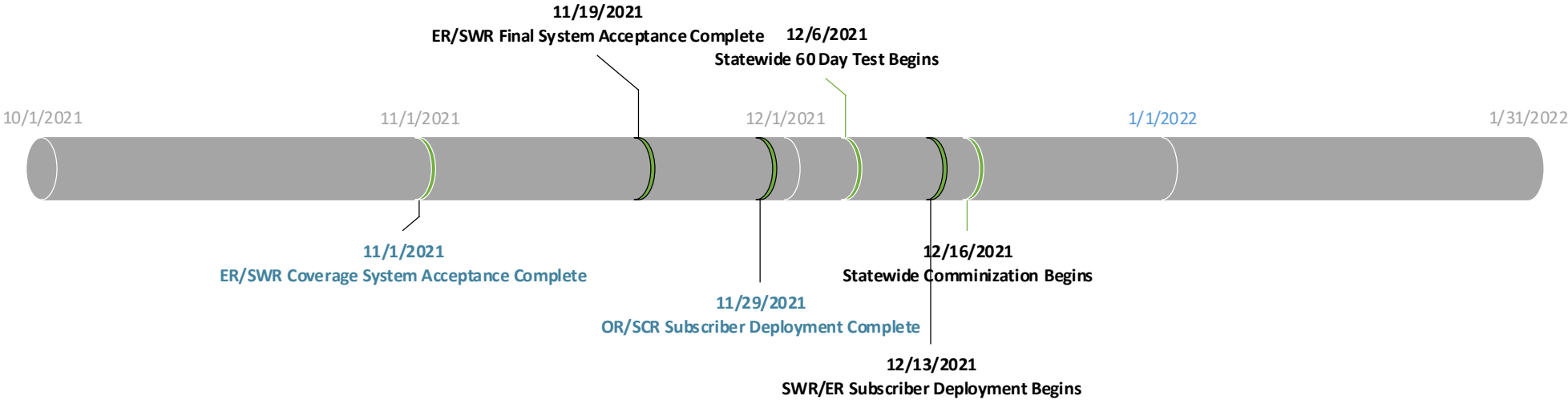
