Sue Langen Scott Broten	Washington state is the first state in the nation to implement a universal long-term services and supports program designed to provide long-term care insurance benefits for all eligible employees. It is a multi-year very complex program that is just getting started. The program implementation involves several agencies, including Employment Security, Social and Health Services and Health Care Authority. The program team provided an overview of the LTSS Trust including cost, how the trust works, implementation timeline and governance.
