Seeing an increase in the amount of phishing attacks through OWA. Would like the CIOs feedback on adding MFA to OWA which would mean if you chose not to enroll in MFA for OWA you would be required to use VPN for remote access. The phishing attacks are getting more sophisticated and we should continue with our security training and outreach to educate staff. #### **Plante Moran Assessment**

Sue reviewed the results of the Plante Moran Assessment on the Project Approval and Oversight Process. See the full report <u>here</u> and TSB Slide Presentation <u>here</u>.

The **Significant Recommendations** from the assessment will result in workgroups that will focus on three separate areas. There are existing workgroups the OCIO might be able to utilize, or add onto, for this purpose. Agency representation will be necessary for the workgroups. Those areas are:

- Recommendation A-E
- Recommendation F & G, minus #5 & 6. G#5 will leverage the existing SEART (Statewide Enterprise Architecture Resource Team) do develop materials that will be brought forward for wider review.
- Recommendation H
