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County Road Administration Board	The Washington State County Road Administration Board (CRAB) provides accountability through standards of good practice, fair administration of funding programs, and engineering and technology assistance to the 39 Washington State County Road Departments in accordance with (RCW 36.78.070). IT Services: GIS, Data sharing, Road rating solutions, MDM, Zero-trust architecture.
Health & Human Services (HHS) Coalition Integrated Eligibility and Enrollment (IE&E) Modernization Program	This multi-year initiative aims to develop modern, integrated eligibility that better supports our clients and staff. The initiative will create a portal where clients can access multiple health and human services programs and streamline the application process. It will feature an eligibility status tracker, enabling easy access to application and benefits information, as well as enhanced self-service functionality.

Office of Minority & Women's Business Enterprises (OMWBE)	OMWBE certifies minority- and women-owned businesses to increase access to contracting and procurement opportunities with Washington state government. We help certified businesses access interest rate reductions on qualifying business loans through our Linked Deposit Program. In addition to certification, OMWBE works with state agencies and institutions of higher education to eliminate barriers to diverse business participation on state projects, improving long-held practices through a lens of equity and inclusion. Secretary of State	The Office of the Secretary of State is responsible for state elections, corporations and charities filings, providing library services across the state and preserving all state archival records and among other services.
Washington Health Benefit Exchange (WAHBE)	WAHBE administers the Washington Healthplanfinder (HPF), the primary portal for Washington citizens to apply for health insurance benefits including Medicaid. IT services include system integration services; call center services; IT professional services; print and mailing services; communications, marketing and outreach products and services; policy consulting and analysis.
Washington State Conservation Commission	The Washington State Conservation Commission (SCC) works to conserve natural resources on all lands in Washington state, through voluntary and incentive-based programs, in collaboration with conservation districts and other partners. IT Services: Data management, Grants, Communication tools, Replacing legacy Access DB, Geospatial Data management
