- WaTech will consider the investment size, risk, and expected impact on residents and operations to determine whether it qualifies as a major <u>Information</u> <u>Technology (IT)</u> investment requiring approval and oversight.
- 2. Agencies will submit investment details to WaTech in accordance with <u>PM-01-01-PR IT Investments Approval and Oversight Procedure</u> for every IT investment with:
 - a. Total cost that includes a combined level of effort of more than \$500,000 OR,
 - b. Duration longer than 6 months.
- 3. WaTech will make the final determination if the investment is or is not a major project subject to applicable oversight processes.
 - a. WaTech will assess the project profile for risks and complexity and assign a Tier to all major projects subject to oversight processes in alignment with the Tiered Oversight Requirements Standard.
 - b. WaTech will share all required and recommended best practice documentation and processes applicable to the assigned Tier with the agency.
- Agencies will follow procedures WaTech establishes for the review, approval, and oversight of major IT investments.

- 5. WaTech will employ Lean principles to implement this policy, continuously improving the procedure and related materials.
- 6. State agencies and WaTech will make critical documentation publicly available using the reporting tools provided by WaTech, in accordance with established procedures and PM01-04-S Tiered Oversight and Reporting Standard.
