Alibi: During the time of the data theft, Charlie was working late in his office, but he claims his focus was entirely on a complex financial report that had to be submitted the next day. He further




claims he had no access to the data that was stolen, nor any knowledge of how to perform a digital theft. He was deeply immersed in his work and didn't notice any unusual activity.
