2	Are you able to share a cad file of the area?	It is for the entire state of Washington.
3	Timeline for purchasing the product	Need by end of summer at the latest, funding dependent.
4	Would it be possible to reformat the RFP so that the section numbers are correct and include page numbers?	Please use the format that is provided.
5	Also, is there a particular layout or format for the vendor's submittal – for example, how should it be organized in terms of sections and sub-sections?	Please refer to Appendix F of the RFP.
6	Will WaTech accept newly acquired imagery collected after contract award? If so, is there an expected delivery timeline or deadline for newly acquired imagery?	Please make your best offer and we will evaluate/ score relative to other responses.
7	Can WaTech provide additional details regarding the expected streaming service requirements?	WMS streaming service that can be consumed into ArcGIS Online, ArcGIS Pro, Computer Aided Design (CAD) and other similar products in use at the state or with our partners.

<b>8</b>	Is the streaming service expected to be hosted by the vendor, or will WaTech host the services internally?	Vendor hosted.
<b>9</b>	Should the full statewide dataset be made available via streaming services, or only specific areas requested by consortium members?	Full statewide dataset.
<b>10</b>	Is there an estimated number of users or expected usage levels (e.g., concurrent users) for the streaming services?	We currently have about 200 user accounts, not all used simultaneously, but need licensing for unlimited.
